

STAY ALERT FOR ANIMALS AT

DAWN & DUSK



PREVENT COLLISION WITH ANIMALS

- Be particularly alert during the peak hours of dusk and dawn and during the fall months.
- Pay attention to the proper signs.
- When traffic permits, use high-beam headlights to spot deer and other animals along the roadside.
- If you see an animal on the road, honk your horn with one long blast to frighten it. Watch for the shine of eyes along the roadside and slow down immediately.
- If you see an animal near the roadway, slow down and alert other motorists with 4-way flashers.
- If you cannot avoid a collision, keep your vehicle in the proper lane. Do not swerve!
